Scheduling:

For all **over-night camps**, registration is from 3:00-4:00 PM on Monday. Junior camps end on Friday at 11:00 AM. Jr. high camps and youth camps end Saturday at 11:00 AM.

Day Camp goes from 9:00 to 3:00 each day (Monday thru Friday) with an optional overnight on Thursday.

Special Needs Camp goes from 9:30 to 2:00 each day (Monday thru Friday). Overnight lodging is available on request.

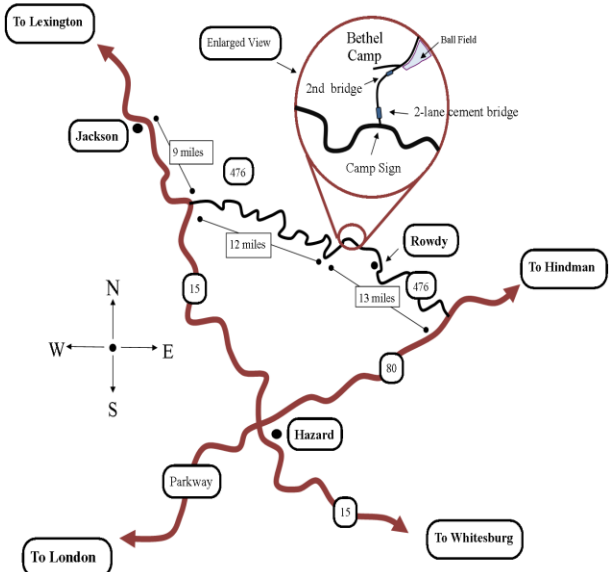
